The Statistics

- Individuals aged 16-24 make up 14% of all drivers
- However, they are involved in 28% of all crashes!

Did You Know?

Motor vehicle crashes are the number one cause of death for people in the 16-24 age group.

- **EVERY** day 31 people in this age group die in a crash
- 49% of these crashes are alcohol related
- **LOWEST RATE OF SEATBELT USAGE**

Alive at 25 Overview

The Mission of the Alive at 25 program is to help young drivers choose safe driving practices, take responsibility for their behavior, and be aware of the typical driving hazards.

- Written and designed for drivers 15-24 years of age
- 4½-hour classroom setting covering **4 sessions**
- No behind-the-wheel driving or training
- Taught by certified law enforcement officers
